### Pep Rally

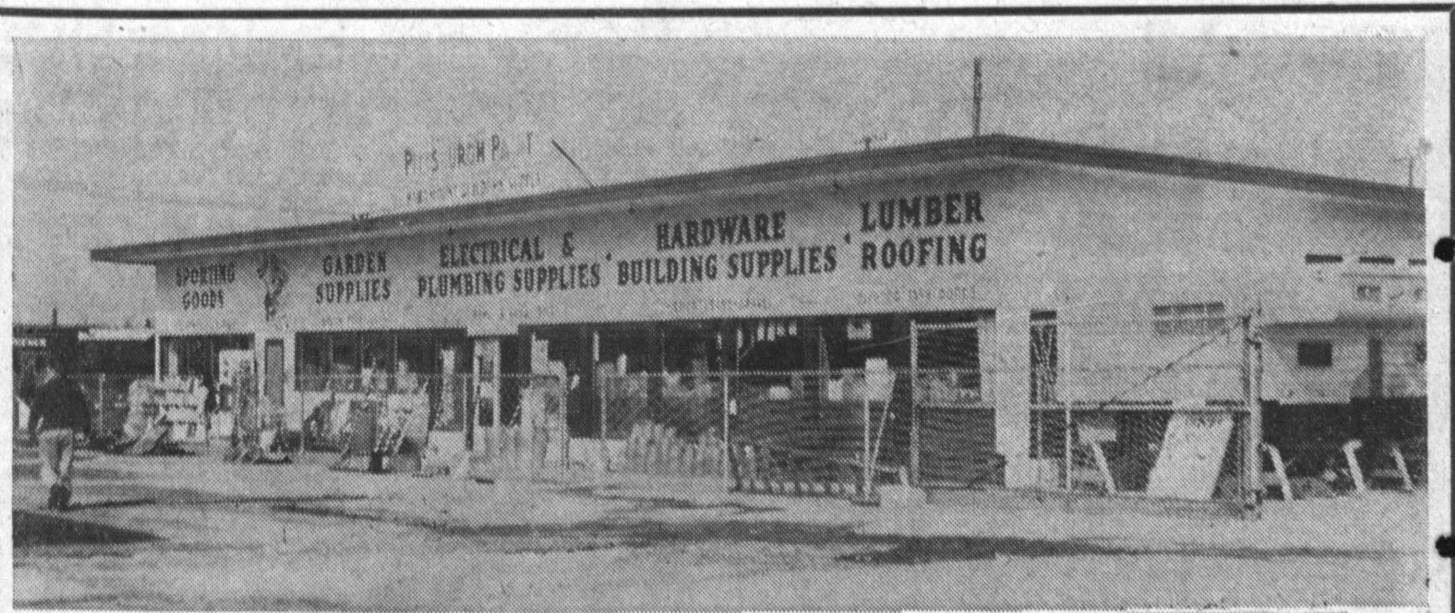
