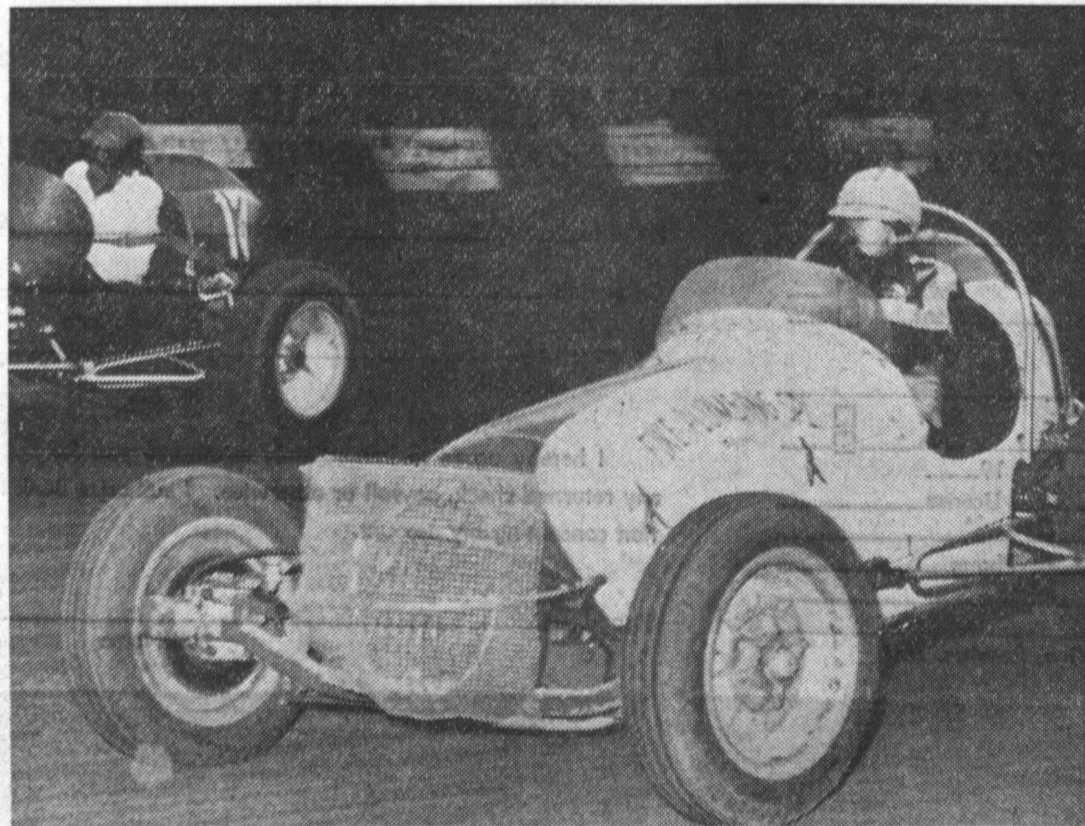

OUTDOORS with MEL

I just returned from a short but fun-filled trip to the Long Beach Breakwater. We used a small boat and motor. It only takes about 25 minutes from the time we put the boat in the water to the time we were fishing.

We left home at 7 in the morning and were back at 12:30 with enough fish to make it a successful trip. I used a light fresh water rod, fresh water reel and 3 lb. test line. For bait we used fresh and frozen Red Shrimp and live Sand Crabs. Our hooks were size 6 and we used a small split shot for weight. We also used small lures and found them fairly successful.

The fish found near the rocks are Opaleye Perch, Catalina Blue Perch, Buttermouth Perch, Calico Bass and Rock Bass. There are also Bonita, Smelt and Mackerel.

If you give these fish a chance on light tackle you will find they give you all the thrill and sport of trout and bass.

We see that more Yellowtail have moved into Rocky Point. They're being taken on live Squid fished right on the bottom. Although the Yellows are not real large. There are many over 13 lbs.

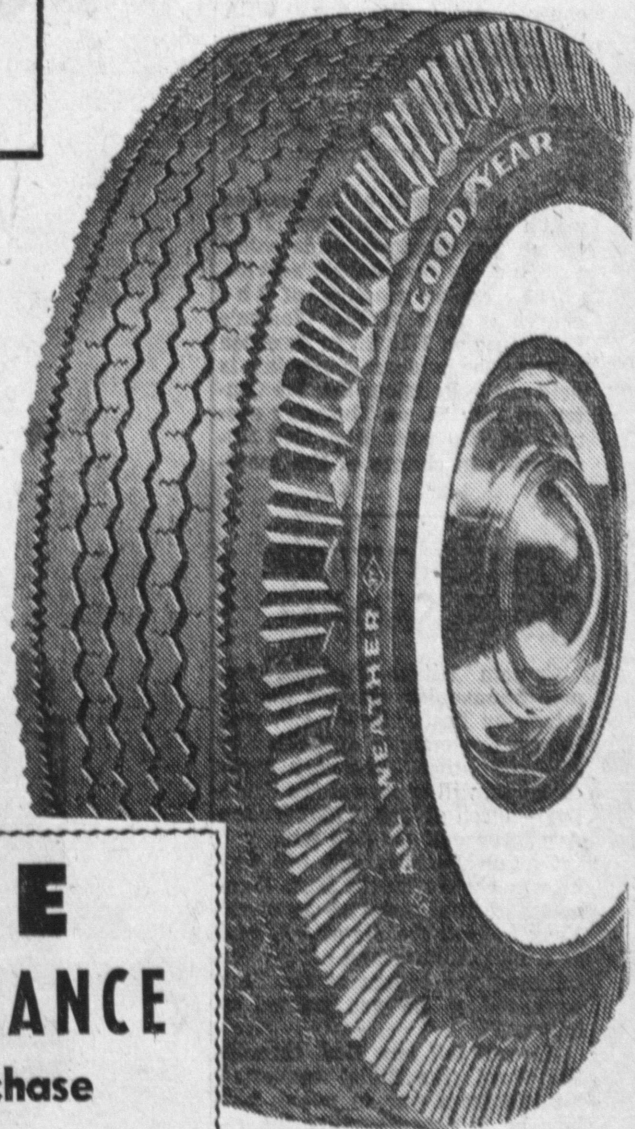
