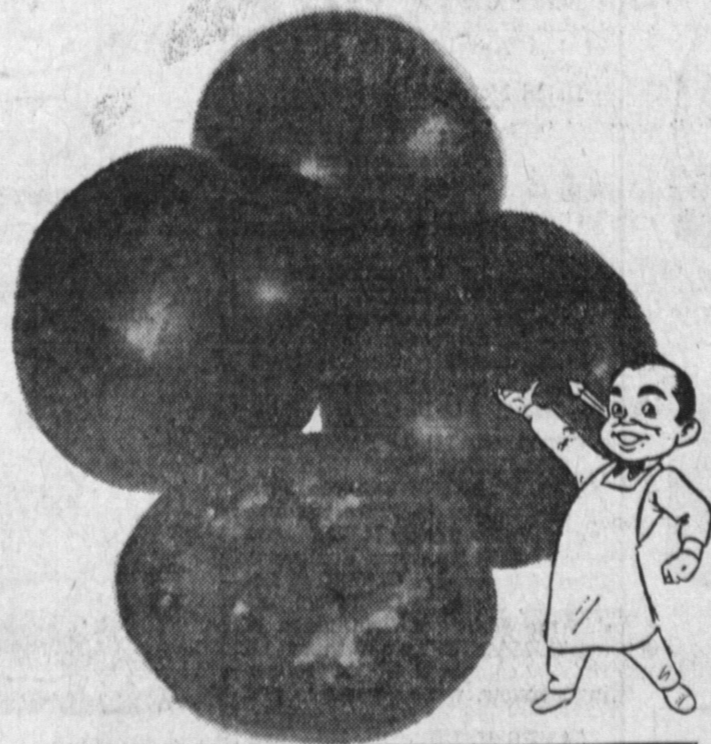

Professor to Speak at Calvary Baptist Church

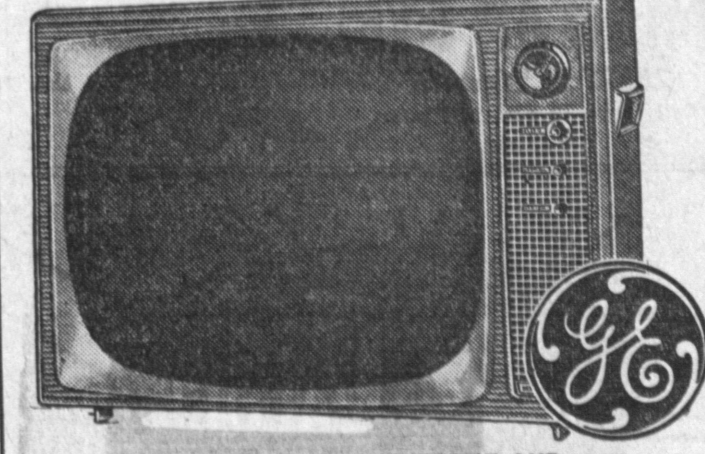
