

### Old City Hall Oral Bids Due at Council Meet

Oral bids for the purchase of the old city hall at 1511 Cravens Ave. will be received Tuesday by the City Council. Only one written offer was received Wednesday when bids were opened. This was from Joseph Fazekas, who offered \$55,000 for the property. Several weeks ago the council decided that if it does not receive bids that it deems adequate, it will use the building to house municipal or civic functions. The Recreation Department has requested use of the building as has the Chamber of Commerce.

### School Overpass Costlier, Later

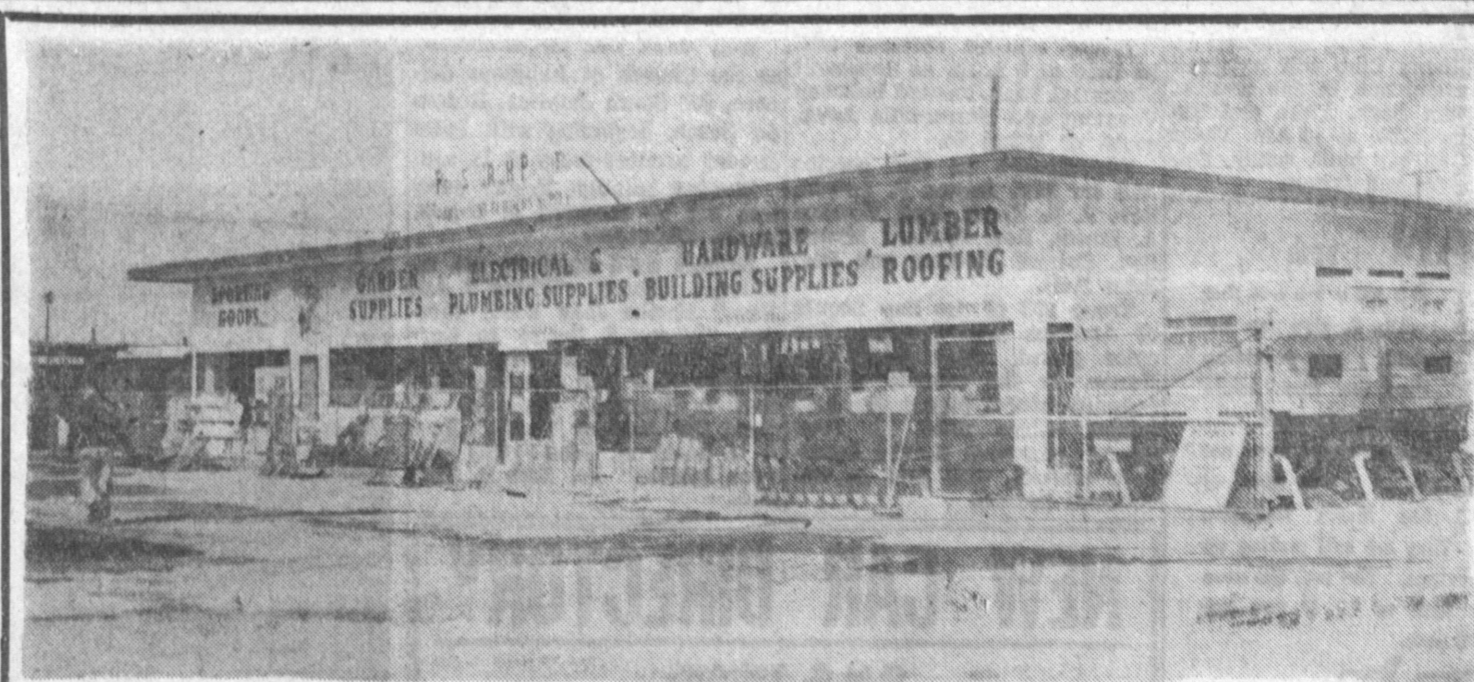
