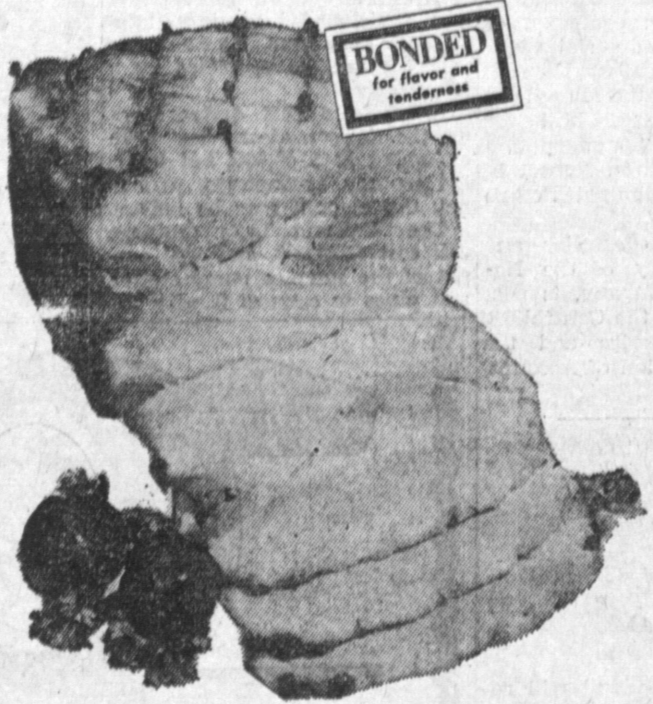

Lee Spangler to Celebrate Bar Mitzvah

The ancient Hebrew rite of Bar Mitzvah—"Son of the Commandments"—will be performed Friday evening when Lee Spangler, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Spangler of 5216 Carmen, is called before the congregation of Temple Menorah, 112 North Catalina, Redondo Beach, at the regular Sabbath evening service.

At age 13, every Jewish boy who has studied Hebrew, the language of the Holy Scriptures, is religiously of age to read the prayers and to recite the blessings over the Bible. This is the first time that he is considered mature enough to lead a congregation in worship. Spangler will read the liturgy from the prayerbook and will also read a passage from the Torah (The Five Books of Moses) and the second selection from the book of Kings. Later in the service he will give a short dissertation on the Biblical passage which he has read and will bless the wine, the symbol of the joys of life.

Mrs. Spangler will light the Sabbath candles, marking the beginning of the service, and Spangler will perform the ritual of handing down the Torah scroll to his son, symbolic of the teachings of God which must be handed down from father to son. The elder Spangler is the chairman of the Temple's Ritual Committee, and is a member of the Temple Board (Governing Body).

Rabbi Henri Front, spiritual leader of the Temple, will preach following the sermonette of Lee Spangler. The ritual music will be sung by Harry Newman, cantor; the Temple Choir is under the direction of Fay Newman, organist. An Oneg Shabbat provided by the Spanglers in honor of their son, will conclude the evening's activities. This service is open to the public, and will begin at 8:30 p.m.
