Request that Gov. Brown appoint a commission to take charge of the 1963 California World Fair was renewed this week by J. A. Smith, president of the group.

Selection of a site for the huge trade exhibit hinges on the appointment of a commission in the near future.

A vast tract east of Torrance is one of six possible fair sites under consideration.

The fair would be a multi-million dollar show to equal or surpass top international shows, its sponsors announced. Many of the buildings would be permanent in nature and remain at the site

Deny Blood Lack Postponed Harbor General Operations

Denial that necessary operations at Harbor General Hospital have been postponed because of lack of blood supply was made today.

But William A. Barr, county superintendent of charities, conceded that some surgery which is elective and non-emergent might have been held up.

In reply to an investigation asked by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, Barr said that on some occasions the hospital had been in short supply of certain blood types.

"When this happens, we telephone one of the laboratories which provide either plasma or blood. This is, however, very expensive and it is preferable to have relatives or friends replace it in the blood-bank," Barr said.

The official said there are problems in relation to maintaining after the fair closes.

The fair supporters previously announced that a site should be selected no later than next month in order that plans and construction can be started.

At headquarters, demonstrations are slated at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m., which will include rescue operations by life line, net jumping and aerial ladder work.

It is requested that parents accompany their children as no children under 12 will be permitted unless accompanied by an adult. Visitors will be allowed to photograph equipment and personnel wherever practicable.

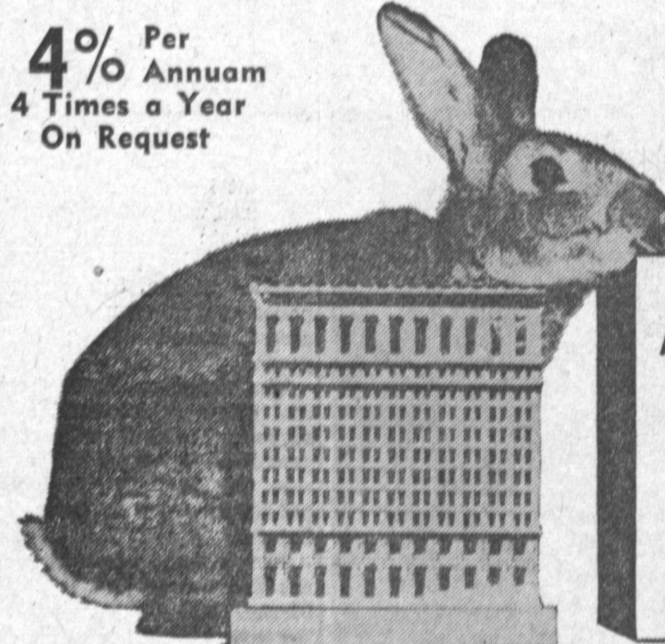
The collision occurred in front of 2911 Dalemead St.
