The California Public Utilities Commission today granted in part and denied in part an application of Cross Town Suburban Bus Lines to raise fares on its Sunset Stages division.
The order, effective May 25, authorized an increase from 12 to 15 cents in the base fare, but rejected the company's request to charge an extra five cents for each additional zone traveled. The Commission also turned down a proposal to discontinue lower fares for children.

Engineer Breakup Claimed

Assertion that a deliberate effort was made to break up the city engineering department was made by Ronald W. Bishop, who quit his post as acting city engineer Friday.
He said he will take a short vacation and then look for another job.
Bishop claimed that the reason he resigned was that a shortage of help and an overload of work made it physically impossible for him to continue.
He criticized breaking up of the engineering staff with no one available to replace personnel which had left in a wave of resignations and extended leaves.
"Nobody asked me to resign, but I ended up with one office engineer and one draftsman in a city of 100,000," he said.
He said with his leaving, the engineering staff will be composed of one office engineer and four draftsmen with numerous projects to be done.
"I did the very best a man could do under the circumstances," Bishop said.
He said that when Wade E. Peebles took over as public works director, he started dumping more work on him despite the shortage of personnel.
Bishop had been city engineer since Feb. 16, 1953, and demoted himself to design engineer in charge of storm drains last December.
