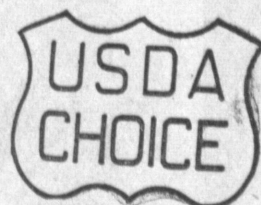

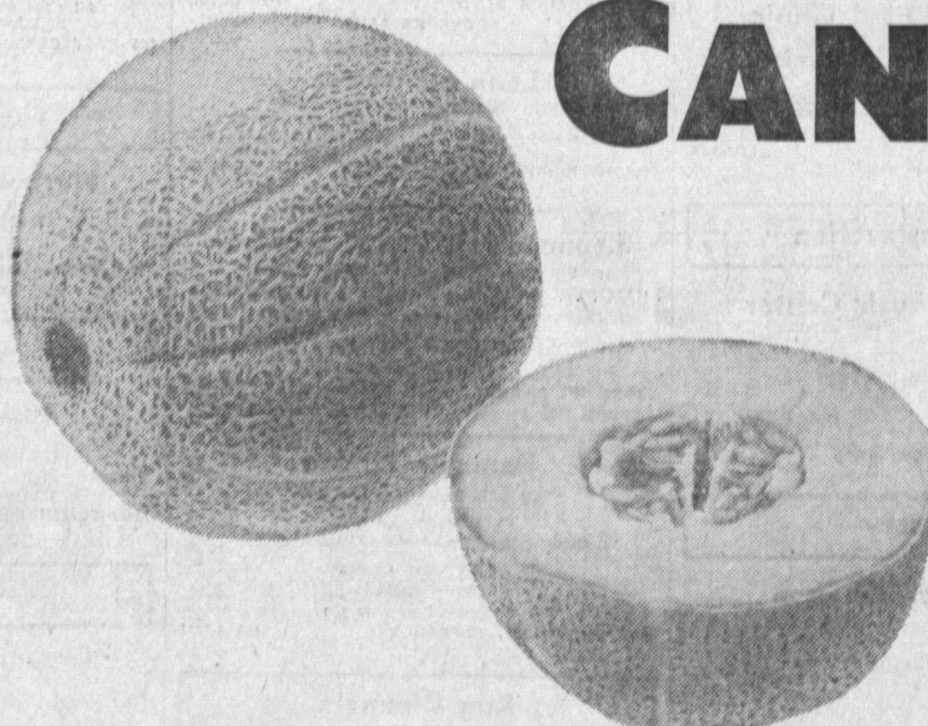

Dr. Ellenhorn to Deliver Temple's Sabbath Service

Dr. Matthew J. Ellenhorn, president of Temple Menorah of the South Bay, will deliver a sermon entitled "Dangerous Thoughts" at the Friday, June 19 services.

The speech will review the thoughts of Dr. Ellenhorn following his two years as the lay head of the only Jewish temple in the South Bay area.

Service will begin at 8:30 p.m. at the temporary Temple, 112 North Catalina, Redondo Beach.

Later this month, Dr. Ellenhorn will travel to London to attend the Annual Convention of the World Union for Progressive Judaism, as a Delegate from the United States, representing the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the parent lay organization of Temple Menorah.

His wife, Syrna Ellenhorn, has been appointed an Alternate Delegate, representing the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods. Mrs. Ellenhorn was a Vice-President of the Temple Menorah Sisterhood this year.

A special Oneg Shabbat (Reception) will follow the Service in honor of the Ellenhorn's departure. Rabbi Henri E. Front, spiritual leader of the Temple, will be in New Hampshire attending the national convention of the Central Conference of America Rabbis.
