He said that the money for the projects is in the bank and at the same time the city is vulnerable to the elements.

Peebles said that his staff is presently not equipped to design these drains. Instead, he recommended that the firm of Koebig and Koebig be awarded the contract.

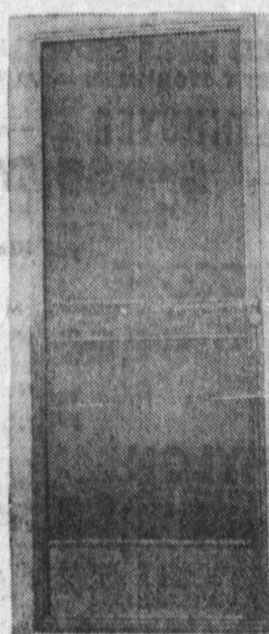
