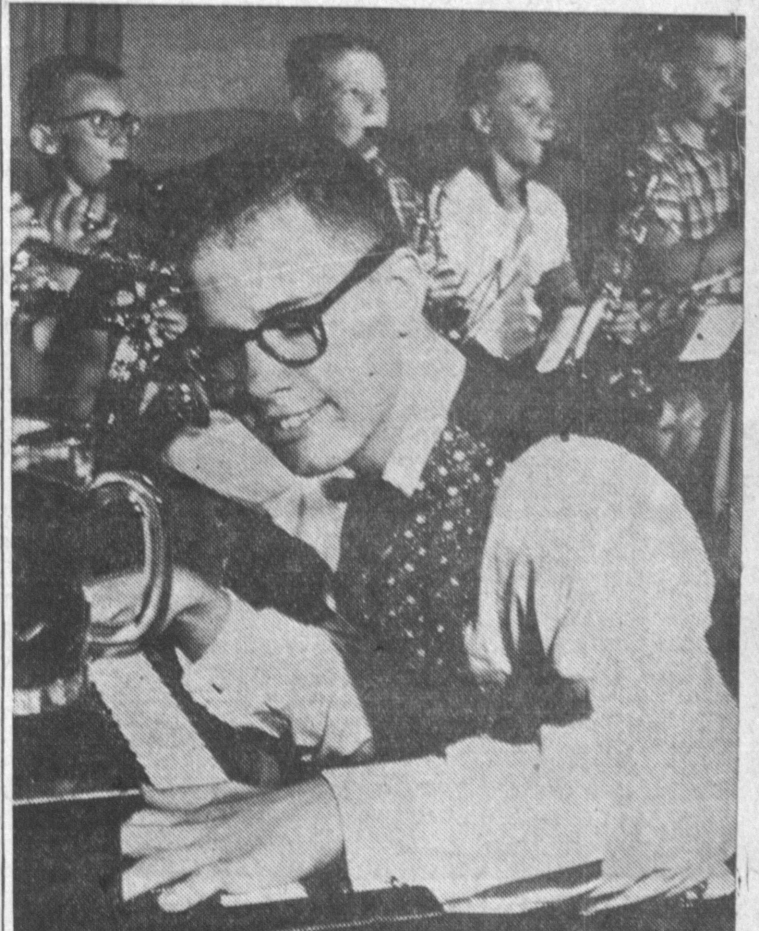

Driver in Crash on Probation

The driver of a car involved in a high speed crash which claimed the life of his stepdaughter, was placed on three years probation.

Jerry Mullin, 26, of Los Angeles pleaded guilty to a manslaughter charge in Inglewood Superior Court.

Six persons, including four of Mullin's passengers were seriously injured in the April 5 collision at Sepulveda Blvd. and Maple Ave.

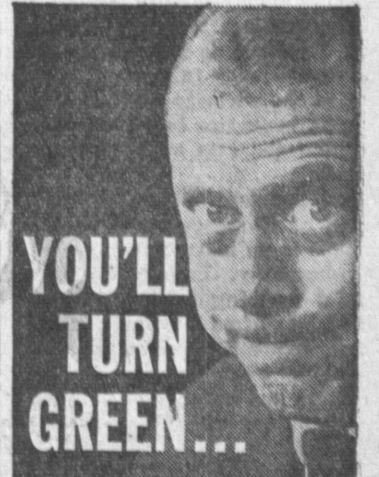
Killed in the crash was Sharon Lucille Tillotson, 7, the defendant's stepdaughter.

Witnesses said Mullin's car had been traveling eastbound on Sepulveda Blvd. at a high rate of speed when it plowed almost head on into an on-coming vehicle.

Mullin's car was nearly cut in half in the collision and the driver himself was also hospitalized.

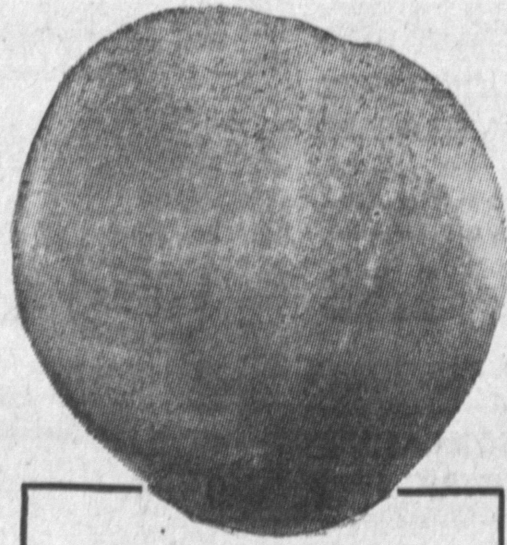
