The accident occurred at 204th and Western Ave., as both cars were moving south on Western.

A car driven by Robinson smashed the rear of the auto of Luis Berduco, 52, of 18109 Amie Ave. Berduco's wife and six children were in the car at the time of the accident. Berduco's car had slowed to less than 10 mph when struck from behind.

Robinson was taken to Harbor General Hospital with minor injuries.

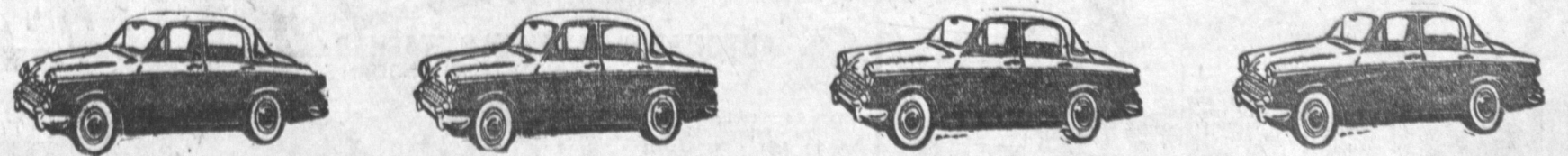

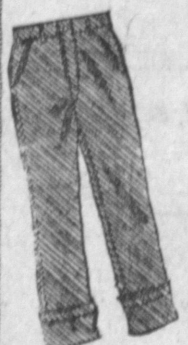
