Whenever I ask him about school or his friends or just about anything else, he just shrugs and says they're o.k. Otherwise he's mum. Makes me feel pretty silly. How am I supposed to get a conversation going? Sad Sack Father

Dear S.S. Father:

Get a conversation going by "going" yourself! Talk about anything that interests you . . . sports, politics, fishing, science, carpentry, your job, or memories of your childhood. Sharing is a two way street, and with a sensitive, quiet 13-year-old, the parent, especially the father, has to go much more than half-way down it to meet his boy. But the journey is worthwhile. Sharing your experiences and your thinking with

your son will be proof to him that you trust and respect him as a companion . . . especially if you share your time and recreation with him as well. After a time he will begin to follow your example and tell you about his life. Children hate to feel that someone is prying or spying. 
