

# Douglas Skywarrior Sets Carrier Record By Taking Off With 84,000 Pounds

A Douglas A3D-2 Skywarrior has set what is believed to be a new record for carrier-based aircraft by taking off an aircraft carrier deck at a gross weight of 84,000 pounds.

The demonstration recently was made during carrier-suitability trials aboard the navy's newest supercarrier, USS Independence.

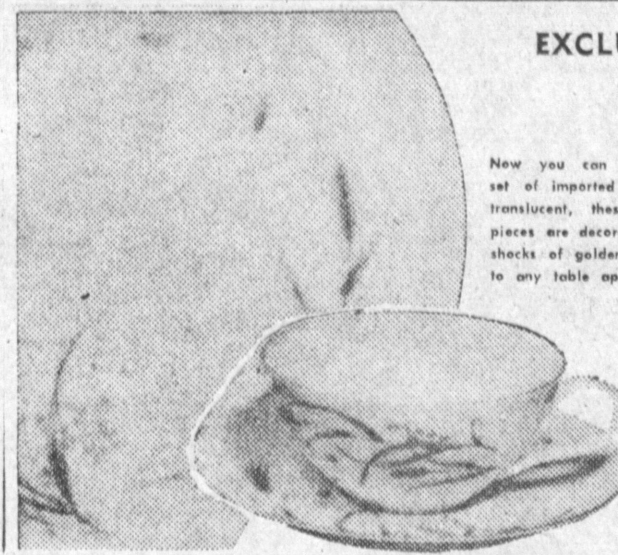
Equipped with the new cambered leading-edge wing, the tanker version of the famed Douglas jet attack bomber made three take-offs at the 84,000 mark.

Minimum airspeed at liftoff from the deck was approximately 143 knots.

The tests were performed to show the capability of launching at that weight with no wind other than that generated by forward motion of the carrier.

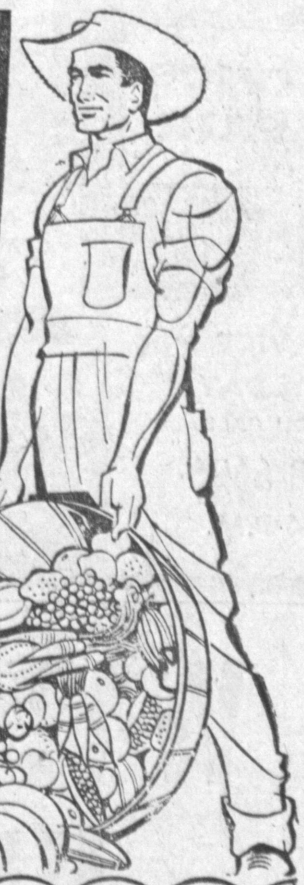
