The Church - sponsored seminar has been arranged by the Rt. Rev. Francis Eric Bloy, Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Los Angeles, and by the Diocesan Commission on Aging, headed by the Rev. Robert T. Stellar, chaplain of the Episcopal Home for the Aged, Alhambra.
