test of all. It is difficult to imagine a more pitiful figure than a small child who is not only blind but whose early experiences have been so cruel that the tot's mind rebels unconsciously. These emotionally disturbed boys and girls, whom psychologists refer to as autistic, unconsciously disassociate themselves from the world around them.

They, are unable to relate themselves either to people to things around them. Their language is gibberish.

The Braille Institute, using money from individuals r bequeathed in wills, this past year has provided clinical reatment for 13 of these children. As a result of this help, some of these youngsters are enrolled in public school. Others are making such progress that it can be expected that they, too, will go to school and become adjusted to their visual handicap.

Requirements are as follows: 1. Honorably discharged from U. S. Navy or U. S. Naval Reserve with a minimum of two years of active duty.

2. Must be able to pass physical examination.

3. Must not be over 39 years
