
## **Award of Merit** Made to 32 Schools

The University of California's annual Award of Merit will be presented to 32 California high schools for outstanding scholas-tic achievement by their grad-uates, while Freshmen in academic 1958-1959, the University's Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools has an-

nounced. The awards, which have been presented since 1940, are given accredited California high schools whose graduates have achieved high collective grade point averages in their first semester of resident study on campuses of the Statewide University. To be considered for the Award of Merit graduates of the high school must have achieved a collective minimum average of grade points, mid-way between "B" and "C." In general only the top 10 percent high schools that qualify for the award are selected to receive it.




