

Local Boat Owners Need New Numbers

More than 2000 Torrance boat owners must apply for their new boat numbers, according to a release received today from the secretary of the California Boating Council, Inc.

Boat registration officially opens March 1, 1960 and will be handled at the California Motor Vehicle Department in Torrance, the release further stated. Carlos Caldwell, manager of the Torrance office of CMVD, said:

"I have not received any official notification from Sacramento but expect to in the next few days. Until I get word, I don't know how it will be handled."

Month to Register

Between March 1, 1960, and April 1, 1960 (30 days), all boat owners, unless specifically exempt under the California Law AP828, must apply for their

new boat numbers.

Sample forms of the application will be mailed to all boating organizations and clubs throughout the state in February by the California Boating Council, Inc. The initial registration fee will be \$5, good for three years.

Cut-off Date Set

After April 1, 1960, it will be illegal to operate your undocumented boat on state waters without a new number. Present

Coast Guard numbers, county numbers or identification other than documentation numbers will have to come off and the new California number put on the bow by April 1, 1960. The same number will remain on the boat, even though ownership may change after the initial California number is issued, except under special cases or in the event the boat is moved to another state.

The U. S. Coast Guard will not number California vessels after March 1, 1960. The U. S. Custom Dept. will continue to document vessels.

Boats which do not fall under the new boat registration

act are undocumented craft propelled solely by oars, paddles or electric motors of 10 horsepower or less; government vessels; boats of 8 feet or less in length which are propelled solely by sail; and documented vessels are exempt. These type craft have been excluded from the California boat numbering program.

Boat owners who fail to apply for their new California boat number between March 1 and April 1 of this year will be subject to a 50 per cent penalty fee in addition to the \$5 registration fee for late filing. Boat owners who operate their boat after April 1, 1960, without a

Area Aliens Failing to File Yearly Form

Upwards of 35,000 aliens have failed to submit address report forms for 1960, area Immigration Service officials said today.

Next Saturday is the deadline for filing the address forms as required under provisions of the 1952 Immigration and Nationality Act.

All aliens, with certain exceptions, must make the report during January of each year. Forms may be submitted at the Torrance post office or at the Immigration Service office at 510 S. Vermont Ave., in Los Angeles.

California number will be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of \$50 if apprehended.

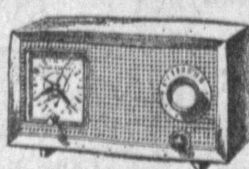

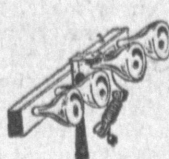
