Torrance Delivers Missile Equipment

Horkey-Moore Associates of Torrance has delivered to North American Aviation, Inc., the first of a quantity of ammonia servicing trailers for the Hound Dog air-to-surface missile, it was announced today.

The Horkey-Moore unit provides anhydrous ammonia to cool certain of the missile's systems.

The trailer, 6 feet high, 10 feet long, 5 feet 6 inches wide, weighs 5300 pounds. It is part of the Hound Dog's ground support equipment, designed to a new concept pioneered by Wright Air Development Center and North American Aviation, weapon system contractor. The units in production at Horkey-Moore's Torrance plant are being produced under a contract won by the engineering firm in a tough evaluation which covered a wide range of technical criteria.
