King Asks End of Pensioners' Earning Limit

Rep. Cecil R. King has introduced a bill in the House of Representatives to remove the limit on what Social Security pensioners may earn without being penalized and remove other inequities in the program which he termed as unwise and unfair.

This legislation would:

1. Remove the \$1200 limit on earned income.
2. Provide earlier retirement at reduced benefits for men at age 62 and for women at age 60.
3. Eliminate the requirement that an individual must have attained age 50 in order to be eligible for disability benefits.
4. Provide a special tax credit against Social Security taxes to employers who employ individuals who are more than 45 years of age.

King said the elderly are becoming one of America's class of forgotten citizens.

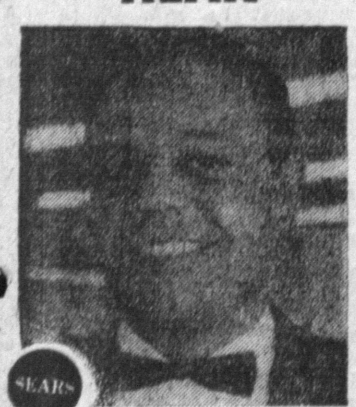
British Author to Lecture Here

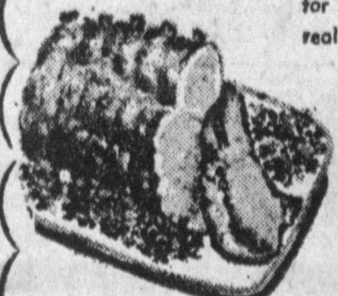

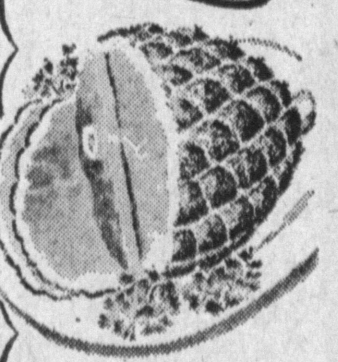
