King Asks End of Pensioners' **Earning Limit**

Rep. Cecil R. King has intro-duced a bill in the House of Representatives to remove the limit on what Social Security pensioners may earn without being penalized and remove other inequi ties in the program which he termed as unwise and unfair.

This legislation would: 1. Remove the \$1200 limit on

earned income. 2. Provide earlier retirement

at reduced benefits for men at age 62 and for women at age 60

3. Eliminate the requirement that an individual must have at tained age 50 in order to be eligible for disability benefits.

4. Provide a special tax credit Bagainst Social Security taxes to employers who employ individuals who are more than 45 years of age.
