The state tax took \$4,189,634. Distributions of distilled spirits was 2,793,000 gallons, an increase of 10.4% above 1958 and the second largest November distribution since repeal.

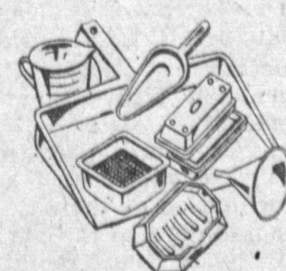

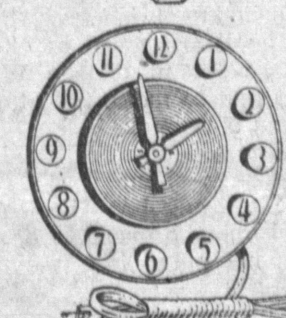
