Education Unit Will Discuss Red Schoolhouse

The Little Red Schoolhouse, a multigrade program that started at Walteria School five years ago, will be the subject of discussion at the Torrance Educational Advisory Committee meeting Monday noon at the Masonic Lodge, 2326 Cabrillo Ave.

Persons attending will get latest reports on the program, which has spread to several other schools in Torrance and other parts of the country. It involves placing children from several different grades levels in the same room.

Taking part will be Assistant Superintendent Albert Posner; Donald F. Mullaney and Roland Petrat, principals of schools which have the program; and Shirley Cullum and R. A. Phelps, teachers at Walteria and Steele Schools.

Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent, will summarize the discussion. Assistant Superintendent S. L. Waldrip will report on the current school building program, and music will be furnished by a Torrance High choral group directed by Roger Axworthy.

Ryan Delivers First Improved Firebee Target

The first production Q-2C Firebee jet target missile built by the Ryan Aeronautical Co. has been delivered to the Air Force.

This new higher performance Firebee will provide the Air Force its most realistic target for maintaining pilots, ground radar crews, and planes at combat readiness.

Production contracts for the Q-2C currently total \$18,600,000. In addition to the production contracts for the target, spares and ground support equipment to be provided by Ryan are expected to exceed \$4,000,000.
