Introduction to business end of army's new M-14

Specialist Uses Latest Rifle

Army Specialists Four Don E. Satterfield, 5127 Emerald St., uses the army's new rifle—the M-14—being introduced to paratroopers of the 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell, Ky. The division is first to receive the new rifle as limited quantities began arriving. The M-14 will give him increased firepower, lighter weight, and easier maintenance without sacrificing the wallop of the present M-1. Designed to replace the M-1, the carbine, the .45 caliber sub-machinegun, and the automatic rifle, the M-14 fires 7.62-mm. ammunition, standard for NATO troops. Satterfield, a squad leader in Company B of the division's 501st Infantry, entered the army in 1955 and last was stationed in Korea.

2000 Expected at Testimonial Fete for L. A. Supervisor Kenneth Hahn

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, will be paid a tribute by friends and associates at a testimonial dinner March 15.

A dinner-dance in his honor will be held in the international ballroom of the Beverly Hilton. Two thousand guests are expected. Dinner will be preceded by a reception in the grand ballroom. Entertainment will feature many of Hollywood's top celebrities.

Hahn's record reaches back to 1947 when he first was elected to the City Council while an instructor in American government and history at Pepperdine. Hahn was re-elected in 1949 and 1951 and elected to the Board of Supervisors in 1952. This was followed by re-election in 1956. In addition to being a member of the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum Commission, he is chairman of the following committees on the Board of Supervisors: auditor-controller, building services, county clerk, John Wesley Hospital, justices of the peace, marshal's office, mechanical services, military and veterans' affairs, municipal court, public defender, public welfare commis-
