Colorado River-Water high and muddy, fishing slow, catfishing good near Blyth with worms best bait. Weather cold but good catfishing at night. Henshaw-Good bass fishing as well as fair Crappie and Bluegill. This is one of the few lakes producing bass on shallow and surface running plugs. Cachuma-Good bass fishing. Fish running smaller than last year with several stringers showing limits of 1 to 11/2 pounders. Piru-Troutfis hing is good with weekly planting of good sized trout. The lake is rising due to recent rain. Cold water has slowed the bass fishing but some are being taken on yellow bombers and hellbenders.




