## Nomination Deadline Set for 'Citizen of Year' Award

Monday is the deadline for nominations for Torrance's "Citizen of the Year" for 1959, as was announced today by the selection committee chairman, Glenn Koger.

Koger said the list is growing rapidly for the award, which will be presented as a highlight of the annual banquet of the chamber March 30 at the Statler-Hilton.

The award, started in 1953 in memory of two departed civic leaders—Dr. William L. Laughon and Grover C. Whyte—is designed to arouse public awareness in civic activity and to illustrate the opportunities available for dedicated community action.

Koger said nominees must live or be employed within the city limits. They will be judged on

answers to two primary questions concerning civic activity in 1959.

Past winners include Mervin M. Schwab (1953), Paul D. Lorange (deceased-1954), Dean L. Sears (1955), Sam Levy (1956), Dr. Howard Wood (1957), and Koger (1958).

Judges include the Rev. Monrad Bergesen, president, Torrance Ministerial Association; Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent, Torrance Unified School District; J. H. Paget, president, Chamber of Commerce; George W. Stevens, city manager; William R. Zappas, publisher, Torrance Press; and all past winners.
