Vincent Lee Isham of Los Angeles today announced his candidacy as Representative from the 17th district.

A realtor, Isham has been active in civic and community projects 15 years. Among his many affiliations is membership in the southwest branch of the Los Angeles Realty Board.

A life-long Republican, he describes himself as a middle-of-the-road exponent.

Isham declared he wants to see the trend in local war plants changed to more active production. When contracts lag, he said, too many plants are being closed or their production curtailed.

He favors reduction in eligible age for Social Security payments from 65 and 62 to 60 in cases of hardship. As a former member of the Operating Engineers, Local 12-B, Isham said he favors fair labor laws.

He wants to maintain a strong military force and a rapidly advancing science and technology.

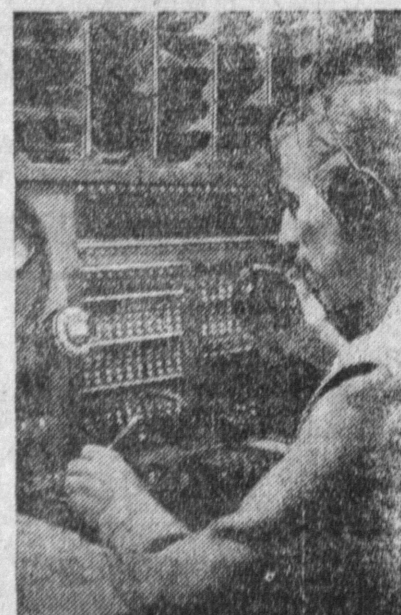

Telephone men wearing headsets aren't too unusual a sight in our business. This man, for instance, makes final checks on newly installed phones to make sure they're ready to use. Also, from his special test desk he traces out trouble reports so repair men can get right on the job. You may never have occasion to see a deskman at work.
