Freedom is the concept which this holy week teaches the observant Jew, and not merely important, freedom for all men everywhere, whether enslaved in hody or shackled by economic or Pharoah's daughter. body, or shackled by economic or spiritual bonds.

Jesus, a practicing Jew, was attending a Seder in the upper room, according to the New Testament description.

The Seder is actually a religious service, replete with special foods symbolizing the rigors of slavery in Egypt and the joy of the new-found freedom.

The Seder is based on the Biblical injunction found in Exodus XIII:8. "And thou shalt tell thy son in that day, saying: it is because of that which the Lord did for me when I came forth out of Egypt."

This refers to the passage in Exodus XIII:3 "Remember this day in which you came out of Egypt, out of the house of bond-

The story leading to the Exodus started when Joseph, the favorite son of the patriarch Jacob, was sold by his brethren to a caravan of merchants on their way to Egypt.

When Joseph grew up, he endeared himself to the offices of the Egyptian government and, because of his wisdom, was called before the king to interpret two dreams which plagued him.

Joseph predicted seven years of plenty to be followed by seven years of famine, and suggested that during the years of plenty, sufficient food be conserved to last during the years of the fam-

tions, Joseph became a minister in charge of food storage and distribution. It was in this capacity that he came face to face with his brothers who came from Cannan to seek food in Egypt because the famine in their coun-

As a result of the interpreta-

Joseph invited his family to come to Egypt where they subsequently settled.

However one of the later kings disregarded the help Joseph had given to the Egyptian Empire as well the loyalty of the Jewish people to state.

Pharaoh who wanted to assure a name for himself in the pages of history, sought to accomplish this by building many castles and pyramids.

Hebrews were regimented into forced labor and it was they, who built the pyramids which stand today as a symbol of tyranny and ruthlessness.

Pharaoh, however, noted that despite the harsh treatment accorded the Hebrews, they continued to increase in numbers. He then sought to dimish the number of Jews by ordering all their male children killed immediately after birth.
