## Corner Lights to Replace Overhead Signals

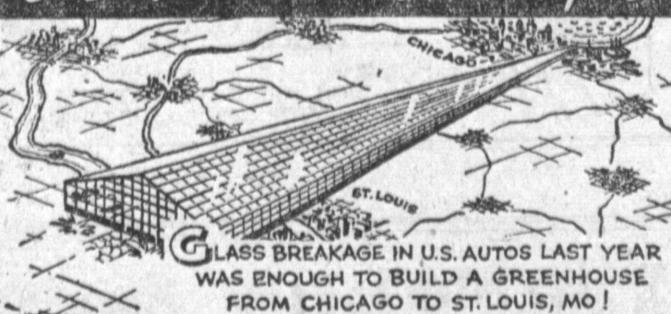
Overhead traffic signals are being removed at the following locations in the city:

## \$1 Polio Shots Will be Given Here Tomorrow

Sponsored by Torrance Elementary School PTA, polio vaccine shots at \$1 each will be given tomorrow from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at Torrance Elementary School, 2005 Martina St., it was announced today by the vaccine department of the National Foundation.

First, second, third, and booster shots will be given to persons of all ages from three months.  
Interval between inoculations is two to six weeks after the first injection and seven months to a year after the second. The fourth shot is administered a year after the third.

Polio is on the increase in Los Angeles County, with 15 cases to date this year, as compared with 14 in 1959. A total of 190 cases were reported last year, and increase of nearly 51% over 1958. Pre-school children were hardest hit, representing nearly half the cases. Next highest incidence was among five to nine-year-olds, followed closely by 20 to 29. Seven cases were reported among persons over 40, four of them past 60 years.
