## SS Catalina Returns to Ply The Blue Waters to Avalon

The SS Catalina, the happy ship which carried a generation of honeymooners and vacationists to fabled Avalon, is coming back to ply the blue waters between Wilmington and Catalina Island.

The great white vessel, shipshape and sparkling, will make her maiden voyage of the 1960 season April 30 with a carefree cargo of fun seekers bound for the island's exotic Buccaneer Ball.

A Long Beach syndicate headed by Charles Stilwell, theater and resort executive, has chartered the famous island ship from P. K. Wrigley, the chewing-gum king whose father invented Catalina Island, and made it the storied playground of the Pacific.

The SS Catalina will make daily round trips to the Avalon

Bay recreationland from May through September. The gleaming ship will sail at 9:45 a.m. from her slip at the foot of Avalon Blvd. in Wilmington, and will dock at Catalina at noon. The return trip sails at 4 p.m., arriving in Wilmington at 6 p.m.

Catalina's sea, sand, and sun recreation season opens with the Buccaneer Ball April 29, 30, 31 and repeated May 6, 7, 8. More than 10,000 thronged the island for the Buccaneer blowout last year, and the event attracted national attention.

Thousands of dollars worth of merchandise prizes and bags of silver dollars, are secreted before the Buccaneer Ball as part of the frantic buried-treasure hunt open to all visitors. Grand prize in the Buccaneer Treasure Chest this year is a power cruiser.

Each guest is given a key, and one of the keys will open the Treasure Chest for some lucky sailor.

Reservations on the SS Catalina for the Buccaneer weekends are being taken at most travel and ticket agencies throughout Southern California, as well as Reno, Tucson, Las Vegas, and San Francisco.

The SS Catalina is licensed to carry 2000 passengers, more than any vessel on the Pacific Ocean.

The interior of the ship has been completely redecorated. The Fantail Room, an intimate cocktail lounge, has been constructed aft on the upper deck. A yacht-like atmosphere prevails in the new bistro.

Capt. Rolf Franz Teuber, salty master of the new vessel, has been in the island service more than 20 years. Chief Engineer L. S. Irwin tops the skippers in tenure with 40 years afloat.

Cost of refurbishing the ship exceeded \$75,000. She cruises at 15 knots, and has been certified safe and seaworthy by marine underwriters and the Coast Guard.

More than 100 school, business and civic leaders will join school reporters in "A Day in the Navy" April 13 and 14.

Principals and journalism instructors will participate in a day-long cruise aboard the Thetis Bay (LPH-6) after touring the Long Beach Naval Base and spending the night there.

Acceptances have been received by the sponsoring group, Public Relations Co. 11-2, from councilmen in many cities, supervisors in five Southland counties, and newspaper editors.

A full program of activities has been arranged for the guests

from the time they step aboard the carrier at 6:30 a.m. on April 14 until they return ashore late that afternoon. Chief feature will be the quick loading into helicopters of combat-ready marines, who will be flown ashore to demonstrate the latest invasion tactics.

Jet planes from a bigger carrier at sea will fly over the Thetis Bay and two submarines will make a simulated attack. Later they will surface close to the ship so the guests may watch the snorkeling process.
