Three Drivers Get Perfect Scores in Car Club Checkup

Members of Torrance's Car Club Associated, sponsored by the police department, came up with a unique result after last Sunday's car-safety check on the Sears Del Amo parking lot.

Three contestants turned in perfect scores. Gary Shrigley of the Charloters, Dick Marion of the Tyrants and Dick Kreutel of the Cardinals racked up a top tally of 564 points.

Object of the safety check, in addition to the obvious reasons, was a first elimination contest for participants in the annual Youth Safety Run between here and Sacramento.

The members' cars were checked for everything from brakes to polish, with points lost for sloppiness, even in personal appearance.

In May the drivers will compete in a special car provided by Dwight Eubank Rambler. One-tenth of a gallon of gas will be metered to each contestant, and the nine members who go farthest will be the Torrance participants in the safety run.

The event will take the drivers over a prescribed course from Azusa. In the capital city, they will be guests of Mather Air Force Base, tour the area, meet with Gov. Brown, and be greeted by legislative representatives from this county.

Sgt. Leland Mason of Torrance Air Force recruiting office has arranged for the boys to be entertained by the air base.

On April 23 and 24, Torrance Officer A. L. Jackson, club adviser, Officer Ted Bradley of the Highway Patrol, and Capt. Harold Thomas of Pasadena police will make the run to Sacramento and arrange gas, lunch and switch stops and check points. In May another run will be made with calibrated speedometer.
