# Paget, Mill, Fitzgerald Will Attend U. S. Chamber Parley

The Torrance Chamber of Commerce will send three delegates to the 48th annual meeting of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States May 1-4—the largest business meeting in the world.

They will be among more than 3000 delegates convening in Washington to decide policies for the national chamber in dealing with the administration and Congress in this election year.

Representing the Torrance chamber will be J. H. Paget, president (J. J. Newberry Co.); Fred W. Mill, immediate past president (National Supply Co.); and Dick Fitzgerald, manager, Chamber of Commerce.

One of the highlights will be showing the Torrance film "Business-Industry-Education Day in Torrance."

The film will be used by the national chamber to promote its B-I-E program nationally. Paget said the national chamber has ordered 11 prints for nation-wide use—the first time in 48 years a local film has been used by the parent group.

The 3000 delegates will act as spokesmen for 26,000 business members of the chamber and 3000 city, state, and regional chambers and professional and trade associations memberships in which total 2,700,000.

They will review and set national chamber policy for tax reform, inflation, labor law, state rights, government competition with business, the federal budget, and government spending. At special dinners, they will discuss these policies with senators and congressmen from their states.

Among speakers addressing the delegates will be Sen. Barry Goldwater (Ariz.) who will discuss "What's Next in Labor Law"; Maurice H. Stans, director of the Bureau of the Budget, speaking on the impact on the economy of the budget surplus; Rep. Bruce Alger (Texas) on "Maintaining a Stable Dollar"; Allan Kline, former head of the American Farm Bureau Federation on farm problems versus politics; Doris Fleeson, Washington news columnist; and Charles H. Percy, president of Bell and Howell.

Once again the national chamber will cite a group of prominent citizens as Great Living Americans—persons who have contributed notably to human progress under free enterprise. National Recognition Awards to chambers of commerce, associations, and business firms for a variety of successful programs will also be announced.

Theme of the meeting will be "Building America's Strength Through Voluntary Action."
