Shoestring Unit Presents Data on Street Job

The Los Angeles Shoestring Strip Councilmanic Advisory Committee for Councilman John S. Gibson Jr. has given property owners information on the 206th and Harvard job.

The project includes streets south of 203rd to Torrance Blvd. and between Western Ave. and including Denker St. Denker will have only paving and curbs and gutters, while the others will include sidewalks.

At a recent meeting of the City Council, no property owner appeared to protest the improvements. Seven written protests were filed. This was believed due to cooperation and education by Gibsons office, which has been working on the project since 1957.

The city attorney's office will check validity of the procedure. After the council receives the report, it will adopt the final ordinance to give authority to call for bids.

After the work has been completed, assessment notices will be sent to property owners. A public hearing will be set to accept any protests as to the quality of work or spread of assessments.

At the committee meeting, Gibson spoke on tax problems of the council.

At this time, he said, there will be no payroll taxes, no additional car taxes, but there is a possibility of a \$1 monthly rubbish-collection charge next year.

The next meeting will be held May 3 at the Normandie playground, 22400 S. Halldale, at 7:30 p. m. Refreshments will be served.
