Boy Pianist Will Star

Jimmy Howard Will Play in **Arts Festival**

The Civic Symphony will pre sent the 12th annual Festival of the Arts May 6, 7, and 8 in Redondo Auditorium. There will be three days of programs crammed with stars.

The symphony orchestra is full of stars from the studios and the Philharmonic as well as many finest local talents. The orchestra will play Saturday, May 7, when they will be heard in Beethoven's First Symphony and Fingals' Cave from Mendelssohn's Hebrides Suite. They are lead by Elyse Aehle, who has received many honors, last year including a citation from county Supervisors and an invitation to go to Europe as guest conductor of some of the large symphony orchestras.

Soloist will be 8-year-old Jimmy Howard of Torrance. With the symphony he will play Haydn's Piano Concerto in C Major which was recently discovered in the State Library in Berlin. It is probable this will be a first performance of this




