

## Danish Ballet Engaged for Greek Theater

The Royal Danish Ballet, oldest dance company in the world with a continuous history, will be one of the featured attractions in the Greek Theater in Griffith Park this season, appearing for three weeks starting Aug. 18.

The company, which will have more than 100 members on the Greek Theater stage, is being flown direct from Copenhagen, under the sponsorship of the Greek Theater Association. In size and quality the vivid troupe compares with the younger Bolshoi and the Sadler's Wells Ballets.

Several local premieres from the company's varied repertoire are scheduled for the Greek program. They will be interpreted by a cast that includes eight noted prima ballerinas and a group of distinguished premier dancers.

Many of us lovers of good food swear by our favorite cheeses. Every cheese seems to have its devotees. There are the cheddar lovers—mild or sharp, depending upon the faction you've allied yourself to, the Roquefort fanciers, the Mozzarella fans, the pasta aficionados who rave about the Parmesan they use with their macaroni or spaghetti.
