

# Aeronica Gets B-70's Unit Contract

Aeronica was placed back into the B-70 program when North American Aviation authorized the firm to proceed with the production of a series of brazed stainless steel honeycomb structures for the "VALKYRIE." While actual money figures were not released, W. W. Rutledge, vice president-Defense Products Group, said the contract was a "sizeable."

The contract received from North American authorizes Aeronica to begin work on the B-70's prototype unit immediately.

In making the award, North American praised Aeronica for its success in this new field of manufacturing stainless steel honeycomb structures.

This recently developed technique provides a high strength insulating material for the B-70, which will fly continuously, over long distances, at speeds three times faster than sound. Conventional aircraft materials, such as aluminum, lose their strength at the high temperatures which will be developed.

According to Rutledge, the production units required for the B-70's development are the large brazed stainless steel honeycomb structures built. The manufacture involves major programs in tooling, process development, welding and quality control along with the brazing.

Rutledge said that one of the structures is a panel more than 30 feet long and 15 feet wide—nearly the size of a passenger transit bus.

"We are extremely pleased to be back in the very vital B-70 program," Rutledge said. "We hope the decision to build a prototype is only the beginning and that the complete B-70 program will be reinstated soon."

## Foreman Sets Record For Working Days

Sidney F. Prigg, crude units area foreman at the Mobil Oil refinery, Torrance, retired this week after setting a record of 38 years of employment without loss of a single day's work.

According to Robert Maescher, refinery superintendent, company records show that no one else has ever approximated Prigg's record of never having been late or absent in over 9,500 working days.
