## 50 South Bay Air Reservists Get Missile Briefing Tonight

A comprehensive briefing on USAF's top offensive ICBM weapons will be heard by more than 50 South Bay area Air Reservists at 7:30 tonight at Lakewood High School, according to Lt. Col. Oscar O. Grab, commander of the South Bay's 9450th Air Reserve Squadron.

Civic and civilian defense officials from many Southland communities, including Torrance, Palos Verdes, Redondo - Hermosa - Manhattan Beaches, and Gardena, have been urged to attend. Much of the information, to be discussed by Maj. Lawrence B. Walker, Atlas project officer from USAF's Ballistic Missiles Division, was formerly classified.

Space vehicles, their planning, development, current production and potential, will be reviewed by Lt. Col. Robert L. Beers, deputy director of programming for BMD.

More than 500 air reservists and civilian officials from the following communities will attend the briefing: Wilmington, San Pedro, Long Beach, Santa Ana, Compton, Whittier, Orange, Anaheim, Garden Grove, El Segundo, South Gate, Fullerton.

## Gas Company Aide Gives College Geology Collection

Trustees of El Camino College today announced acceptance with gratitude of a geological collection from W. T. Schell of Redondo.

The board accepted the gift from Schell, Southern California Gas Company employee, in behalf of the faculty and students.

Thirty years of work and collection are represented by the specimens, which include plant and fish fossils found by Schell and his uncle, M. E. Schryver, as well as some important specimens of polished agate.

Much of the material was collected in the Mazon Creek area of Illinois and is primarily an example of coal-

age plant life. Oldest among these fossils is a fern specimen of plant foliage.

Of the fish-life fossils, one is a skeleton from the Green River formation in Wyoming and is dated as 40,000,000 years old. Another specimen, a fossilized trilobite, shows the bone structure of the forerunner of modern-day crabs and crayfish.

## Pool Program Announced at El Camino

Registration for the summer swimming program of El Camino College will take place at 8 a.m. June 18 in the Campus Center.

Enrollment will cover three instructional periods, from June 20-July 1; July 5-15; and July 18-20.

Instructional tickets will be offered for sale on the registration date and participants may purchase tickets for the three periods.

Cost is \$1 per two-week period. Purchases may be made for one period at a time but buyers may re-enter for subsequent periods.

Ten instructional hours have been established daily from Monday through Friday for swimmers utilizing the college pools. Minimum age of swimmers is seven and minimum height is 50 inches.

Adult instruction for persons over 18 years is scheduled in the evening from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. and 8 p.m. to 9 p.m.

The program is supervised by college physical education instructors and student recreational leaders.

Opportunities for recreational swimming at a cost of 10 cents per child under 18, and 25 cents per adult are available Monday through Saturday. No registration is necessary.

Weekday recreational swimming is scheduled for the evening and children under 18 must be accompanied by parents. Saturday recreational periods have the seven-year and 50-inch minimum requirements.

All swimmers must furnish their own suits and towels. Bathing caps for girls are required.

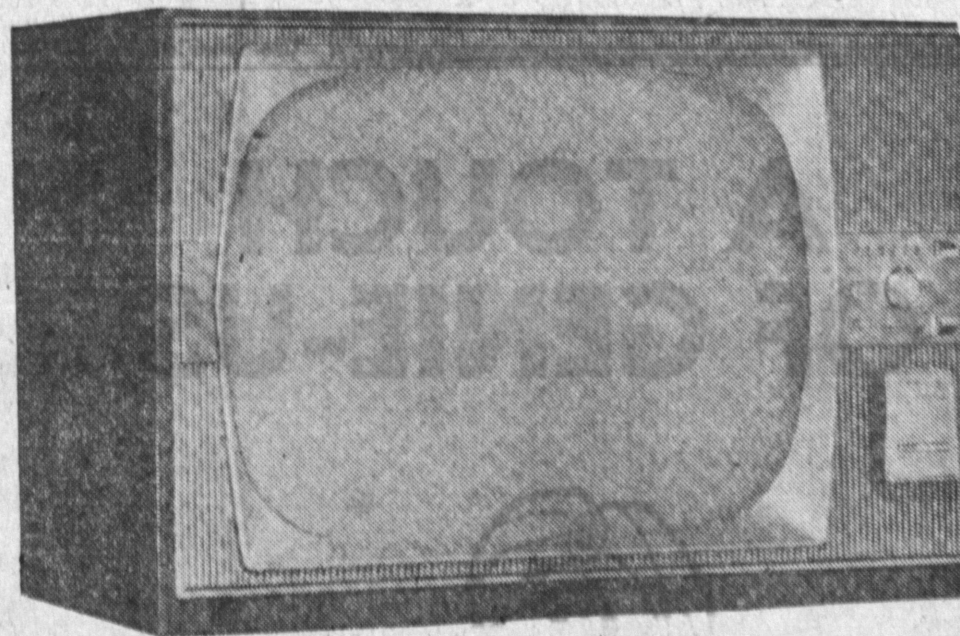

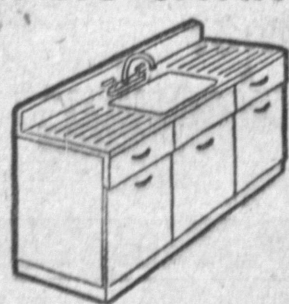
