

Senator Hails End of Gyps in Assigned-Risk Insurance

For some time now, many of us have felt that one of the most flagrant, and yet uncontrolled, abuses in automobile insurance has been the extremely high cost of policies charged to the so-called "assigned risk" insured.

In the last fiscal year 1959, 534 drivers were required to obtain insurance on this assigned-risk basis.

Some of these drivers were victims of unscrupulous insurance agents charging 200% above the regular cost of similar programs.

I was glad to note that on May 3 State Insurance Commissioner F. Britton McConnell, announced that effective July 1, the cost of this special coverage would be limited to no more than 15% of the regular insurance premium rate.

This new ruling came into effect after McConnell, Gov. Brown, members of our Legislature, and a committee composed of insurance executives met in November, 1959, for the express purpose of considering what actions could be taken in the face of numerous complaints from drivers and responsible leadership in the insurance profession.

From this and other meetings there came to the legislators' attention a request for provisions within the assigned-risk law requiring that body-injury and property-damage insurance under the assigned-risk plan be made available at fair rates to those persons "who are in good

faith and entitled to, but unable to procure, such insurance through ordinary channels."

The Legislature also in a few provisions for recognition of certain relevant and obviously significant discriminatory acts by the following statutory language: "Such plans (assigned risk) shall contain standards for determining eligibility of applicants for insurance, and in establishing such standards the following may be taken into consideration in respect to the applicant, or any other person who may reasonably be expected to operate the applicant's automobile with his permission.

"1. His criminal conviction record, 2. his record for suspension or revocation of a license to operate an automobile, 3. his automobile accident record, 4. his age and mental, physical, and normal characteristics, which pertain to his ability to safely and lawfully operate an automobile, 5. the condition or use of his automobile."

Under the McBride-Grumsky Insurance Regulatory Act it is provided that "rates shall not be excessive or inadequate as herein defined, nor shall they be unfairly discriminatory."

Lachlan M. Richards, chief of the Division of Small Craft Harbors, today said the state boating law contains no provision whatsoever requiring vessels to be insured.

The division has been told that certain groups have been informing boaters that insurance is mandatory.

The division wants the public to know that boat insurance, in any form, is neither required nor compulsory.
