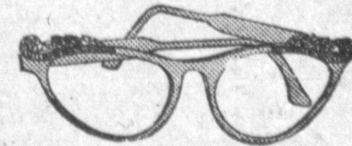
straight-A average for four years was considered exceptional. In addition to a cash award, Meggitt will receive a plaque later. Miss Mathlin will receive a second-place plaque.

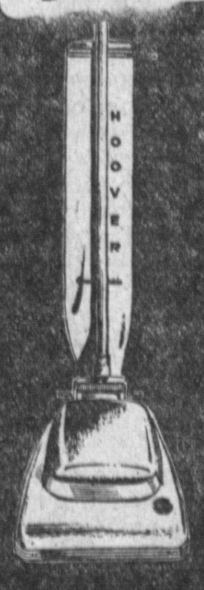

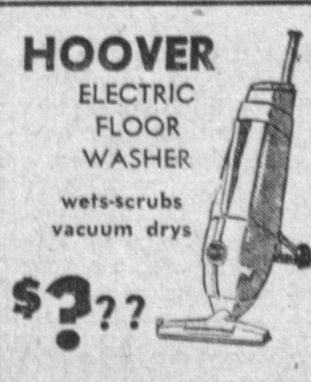

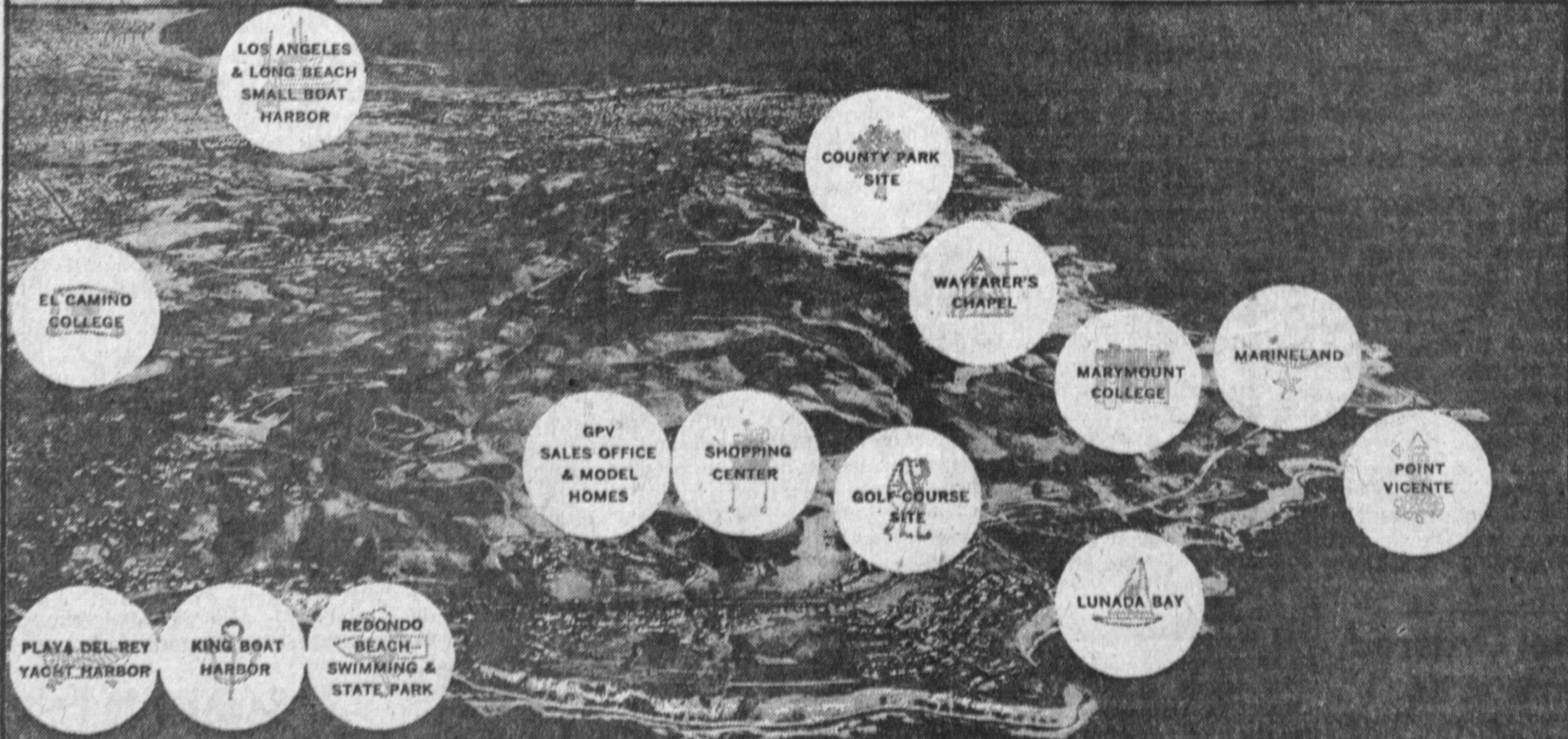
