## Large Audience Hears Recital by Pianist and Percussionist

The Young Artists' Concert presented by the South Bay Branch of the Music Teachers' Association of California recently drew a large and responsive audience to hear pianist Doris Anne Hendin and Richard Sternberg, tympanist and percussionist.

Miss Hendin, a graduate of the Sherwood School of Chicago, holds a bachelor degree from Whittier College and a master's degree from Los Angeles State College. She opened the program with Arioso by Bach-Pirani, followed by a Chopin group and closed the program with a suite of pieces from the Children's Corner by Debussy and the Waltz from the ballet "Naila" by Delibes-Dohnanyi.

Miss Hendin included descriptive remarks prior to the playing of each group.

Sternberg, 17 years old, has made numerous appearances on radio, television, recordings and in movies, having had a featured role in "The Eddy Duchin Story." He recently was awarded a scholarship by the Burbank Music for Youth Association.

Appearance of a tympanist of his high caliber is unusual, and much interest was shown in the numbers offered by Tocatta by Chavez, Tympano by Schiniste, and Suite for Percussion by Sternberg.

Presentation of these young artists in public performance

is a project of the Music Teachers' Association in assisting deserving young musicians in their professional careers and is sponsored and supported by the various branches throughout California.

The South Bay branch, sponsor of this concert, includes in its membership teachers and performers from Redondo Beach, Torrance, Palos Verdes, Portuguese Bend, Waverly, Wilmington, Hawthorne, Inglewood, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and El Segundo.

Its president, recently re-elected for a second term, is Maryestelle Ford of El Segundo.
