Three Riviera Scouts to Win Eagle Pins at Honor Court

John Bereda, Alan Rich, and John Reynolds of Hollywood Riviera's Troop 718 of the Boy Scouts will be presented at a Court of Honor ceremony Scouting's highest award, the Eagle Scout Medal, on Tuesday.

Hiking up the "Eagle Trail" towards their goal over many paths of spirit and adventure, and of knowledge and achievement, these boys are representative of about 2% who have reached the highest rank in Scouting. Outstanding among their previous accomplishments was the earning of the Troop camping medal (given for a least 50 nights of camping under the stars, plus merit badges

in first aid, camping, cooking, and hiking). All three boys have also received the Golden Arrowhead Medal for enduring a rigorous one-week mountain trail hike. Bereda and Reynolds were chosen for the Order of the Arrow, and John Bereda was also given the Troop award of Scout of the Year.

Having worked hard toward earning part of his way, Rich will attend the National Scout Jamboree at Colorado Springs in July as part of the celebration of the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Boy Scouts of America.

Highlights of the jamboree trip will be a tour visiting the Grand Canyon, Salt Lake City, Yellowstone National Park, and San Francisco, and the meeting at Colorado Springs of hundreds of Scouts from every state.
