Plans Being Completed for Ranchero Days and Rodeo to Be Held Here During July

Torrance's fourth annual Ranchero Days celebration will be held July 20 through July 24, according to chairman Jack Phillips, of the sponsoring Torrance Chamber of Commerce. All events will be held at the Torrance Civic Center. Although this year's event will not include the customary parade, it's being replaced by the Armed Forces Day parade May 21, the celebration will include a gigantic fun zone and an expanded number of organization-sponsored food and game booths. Another major change will be that the RCA Championship Rodeo will not be on the same weekend but will follow on Saturday and Sunday, July 30 and 31, under sponsorship of the Torrance Mounted Police and the chamber. The change was made, rodeo chairman D. C. Cook said,

in response to wishes of residents who felt that the conflicting activities made it difficult to attend the rodeo.

All proceeds from the event will be donated to the Torrance Tournament of Roses Association to pay for the community's entry in the annual Rose Parade in Pasadena.

Torrance entries, supported largely by Ranchero Days proceeds, have won two first prizes and one third place award in three years of competition.

An organization meeting of all interested Torrance civic groups will be held soon to assign food and game booths, Chamber officials said.



School Principal Resigns to Take Huene Post

Earl W. Eckert, long-time principal in the Torrance Unified School District, Tuesday resigned to become assistant superintendent of schools for the Huene School District. He will depart July 1.

Currently principal at Crenshaw Elementary School, he previously served as first principal of Seaside Elementary School and as principal of the old Torrance Junior High.

At his new post, Eckert will be assistant superintendent in charge of instruction. The district is located at Port Huene.

Eckert came to Torrance in 1957, first year of operation for Torrance schools. He previously taught at Arcadia and in Washington.

He is a native of Washington and graduate of the Western Washington College of Education. He has a master's degree from USC and is working on a doctorate.

An Army veteran, he is retiring vice president of the North Torrance Lions Club and is a former chairman of the board at the First Christian Church.

He and his wife, Beth, live at 805 Hickory Ave.
