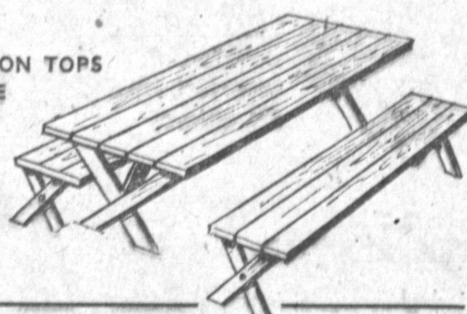

3 New Principals, 2 Vice Principals Named to Schools
