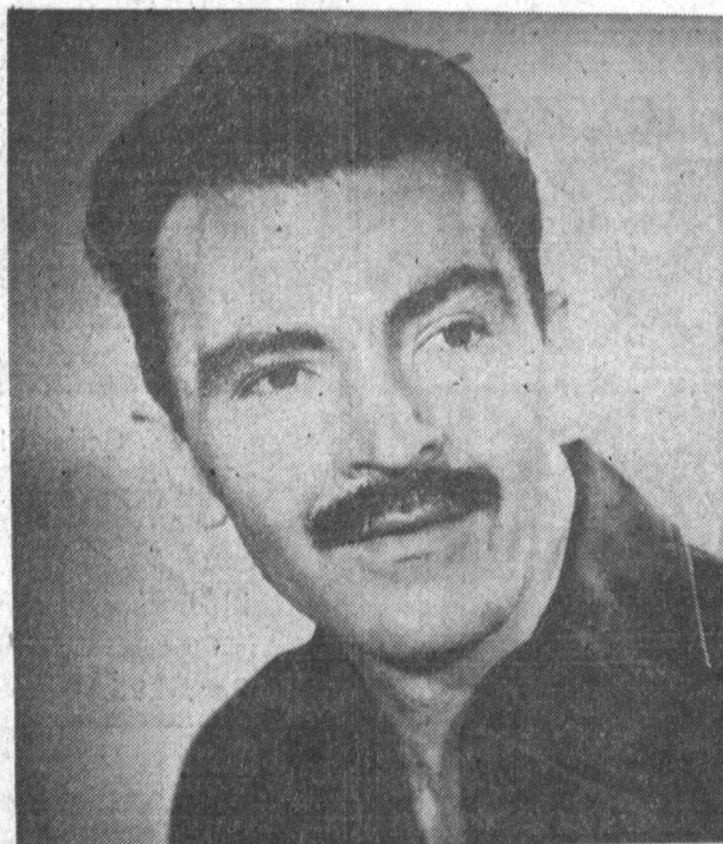

### Education Group Aids 23 Charities

Twenty-three charities benefited as a result of the 1959-60 Torrance Education Association charity drive, according to R. K. Petrat, chairman.

Torrance teachers collected more than \$7423, he said, of which more than 80% will be assigned to local charities.

Largest single portion of the money—\$1800—went toward three scholarships for seniors graduating from the city's high schools who plan on teaching careers.

The grants were given to Robert Bereskin, North High; Mitzie Yoshioka, South High; and Carol Faye Johnson, Torrance High.

A \$650 scholarship for the American Field Service program was allotted for use of the organization.

Other major local charities included Torrance Community Chest, \$932; Torrance Dental Health Association, \$760; and Torrance YMCA, \$773.

Other recipients included the Cancer Society, \$653; the Heart Fund, \$457; Mental Health Association, \$381; Arthritis and Rheumatism, \$205; Multiple Sclerosis, \$203; Muscular Dystrophy, \$171; Cerebral Palsy, \$165; American Red Cross, \$114; Salvation Army, \$62.

Also benefiting were City of Hope, National Diabetes Association, Boy Scouts, CTA Welfare Fund, USC Building Fund, Primary Children's Hospital, Torrance Elementary PTA scholarship, American Martyrs Church and the Civitan Club Charities.

## Thousands Hear Lecture on Love at Convocation

Thousands of persons attending the Seventh-Day Adventist, Lynwood, last night heard a world church official state that "Obedience without love is slavery. Love without obedience is hypocrisy. Obedience with love is Christianity."

Archa O. Dart, Washington D.C., a world director of home and parent relations for the Seventh-day Adventist Church, spoke on "Is it Love?" to the denomination's 57th annual Southern California Camp Meeting now in session at 6 p.m.

"Obedience is love in action," Dart told some 7,000 persons at the session.

Citing a growing problem in child rearing which finds love left out he charged, "The child often hears more swearing from the father than words of prayer and praise. Twice as many children now go to the movies as to Sunday school classes, and each child that goes to the movies spends twice as much time therein as in Sunday school."
