

State Controller Reveals Per-Pupil Annual Costs

Average California school district expenditures in the 1958-59 school year were \$351.35 for an elementary school pupil, \$533.73 for a high school student, \$598.26 for a junior college student, and \$413.69 for a pupil in a unified district.

These annual costs per pupil, embracing general fund expenditures, were revealed by Alan Cranston, state controller, as his office issued a report on school district financial transactions.

Comparable figures for the prior year were \$342.75 per pupil at the elementary level, \$528.41 at the high school level, \$580.43 at the junior college level, and \$401.54 for a pupil in a unified district.

Cranston defined a unified district as one in which the boundaries for all districts are coterminous and administration is handled by a single school board.

Daily costs per pupil in 1958-59, based on a school year of 175 days, were \$2.01 in elementary schools, \$3.05 in high schools, \$3.48 in junior colleges, and \$2.42 in unified district schools, Cranston said.
