NOTICE OF IMPROVEMENT
 IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY IMPROVEMENT NO. 2188-M (BERENDO AVENUE) NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT AT ITS MEETING ON THE 5TH DAY OF JULY, 1960, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA ADOPTED A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION WHICH DECLARED THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD TO ORDER THE ACQUISITION OF THE NECESSARY RIGHTS OF WAY AND TO ORDER WORK TO BE DONE AND IMPROVEMENT MADE AND THAT ON THE 5TH DAY OF JULY, 1960, A REPORT CONSISTING OF PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AN ESTIMATE OF COST, A DIAGRAM AND PROPOSED ASSESSMENT WAS FILED WITH THE BOARD AND THAT ON THE 5TH DAY OF JULY, 1960, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD SETTING THE 25TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1960, AT THE HOUR OF 2 O'CLOCK A.M. AS THE DAY AND THE HOUR AND THE PLACE OF THE BOARD IN THE HALL OF RECORDS IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AS THE PLACE FOR HEARING THE BOARD FOR HEARING PROTESTS IN RELATION TO THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT.

The proposed improvement shall include the acquisition of permanent sanitary sewer rights of way consisting of a strip of land 6 feet wide lying southerly of and adjacent to a line parallel with and approximately 445 feet northerly of the northerly line of Carson Street between a line parallel with and approximately 16 feet westerly of the westerly line of Berendo Avenue; and a strip of land 25 feet wide lying northerly of and adjacent to the northerly line of Carson Street between Berendo Avenue and Vermont Avenue; and the acquisition of a temporary right of way for construction purposes consisting of a strip of land 10 feet wide lying southerly of and adjacent to the above described 6 foot strip of land, and the construction of sanitary sewers and appurtenances in THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PERMANENT SANITARY SEWER RIGHTS OF WAY, and in 14TH STREET between Vermont Avenue and a line approximately 130 feet easterly of the easterly line of Tract No. 2488; and in CARSON STREET between a line approximately 65 feet westerly of the easterly line of Lot 25, Tract No. 3012, and said last mentioned easterly line, and in and adjacent to the intersection of CARSON STREET with Vermont Avenue; and in BERENDO AVENUE between a line approximately 510 feet northerly of the northerly line of CARSON STREET and CARSON STREET; and in VERMONT AVENUE between 21st Street and the southerly line of Carson Street; and the reimbursement for a portion of the cost of existing sewers outside of this improvement district which will be used for the disposal of sewage from within this proposed improvement district.

The work of improvements aforesaid shall be done and performed as shown on and in accordance with and to the scales shown on said plans and specifications included in said Report. A map of the district, indicating by a boundary line the extent of the territory included in the proposed district, approved by the Board on the 14th day of July, 1960, is on file in the Office of the Board. Reference is hereby made to said last mentioned map for a further, full and complete description of the assessment district, and said last mentioned map shall govern for all details as to the extent of the assessment district.

The total estimated cost of the proposed acquisition, improvement and reimbursement is \$40,000.00. THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROPOSES TO FIND AND DETERMINE THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE SUCH ACQUISITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS AT THE TIME AND PLACE HEREIN FIXED FOR HEARING OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS TO THE MAKING OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT A PUBLIC HEARING WILL ALSO BE HELD PURSUANT TO LOS ANGELES COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 767, TO HEAR OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS TO THE MAKING OF SUCH FINDING AND DETERMINATION BY THE BOARD. AFTER SUCH PUBLIC HEARING IF THE BOARD BY A VOTE OF NO LESS THAN A FOUR-FIFTHS VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF, FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE SUCH ACQUISITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS WITHOUT FURTHER PROCEEDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE DIRT LIMITATION OR MAJORITY PROTEST PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 4 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

Serial bonds shall be issued in accordance with Division 7, Streets and Highways Code (Improvement Act of 1911), to represent each assessment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or more remaining unpaid for thirty (30) days after the date of the recording of the Diagram and Assessment for this improvement. The serial bonds shall extend over a period ending nine (9) years from the second day of January next succeeding the next September 1st following their date.

The principal sum shall become due and payable to the Treasurer in equal annual payments on each October 15th succeeding the September 1st following their date until fully paid. The first interest payment shall be payable to the Treasurer on the April 15th next succeeding the March 1st or the October 15th next succeeding the September 1st, in the case may be, next following the date of the bonds. The following interest payments shall each be for six months interest and shall be payable to the Treasurer on each fifteenth day of April and October, the last interest payment coming due the October 15th immediately preceding the last annual payment; the principal of the bonds issued to represent the unpaid assessments.

The bonds shall bear interest at a rate to be determined on the sale thereof provided, however, that said rate shall not exceed the maximum rate of 6 per cent per annum.

The proceedings for the aforesaid acquisition, work improvement and reimbursement shall be under and in accordance with the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California designated and known as Division 12, Streets and Highways Code (Municipal Improvement Act of 1911).

Any person interested in, or objecting to said improvement, or the acquisition proposed to be had, or to the work proposed to be done, or the proposed reimbursement, or to the extent of the assessment district, or to the proposed assessment or to any or all of the foregoing, may file a written protest with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at or before the time set for the hearing as hereinabove set forth. For further particulars, refer to the above mentioned Resolution of Intention and "Report".


