State Agencies Report Unemployment Rise

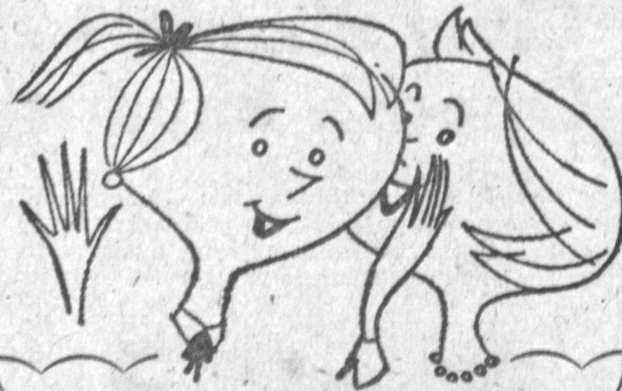
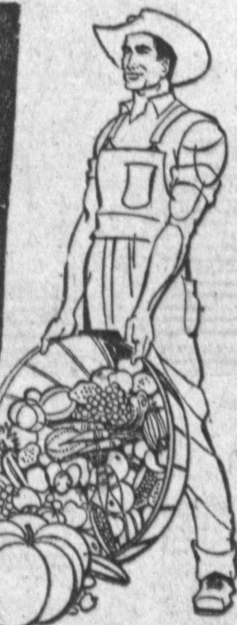
There was a marked increase in California unemployment in June, reflecting a smaller than usual rise in civilian employment from May, two state agencies reported today. Irving H. Perluss, Director of Employment, stated that the number of unemployed rose to 325,000 in June, which was 20,000 above the figure for May, and 91,000 or 39 percent above the year ago level. The May-June 1966 increase reflected the entrance of summer workers into the state's labor force.

it. Planning determines the highest potential use of land. Within the past year there have been over fifty inquiries by industrial developers seeking to find land for industrial development in the City of Torrance.

"There is absolutely no consideration being given to rezoning any M-2 industrial land in the City of Torrance for residential use, excepting one parcel owned by J. Paul Getty, which unfortunately was sold for residential development," Powell adds. Torrance Mayor Albert Isen maintains "the city council was told that if the school district would qualify, the land would be an out and out grant." "At the government selling price, if the land were deeded to the school board, it could get the land at a fraction of its cost." The city could not afford to buy the land for it would mean raising the tax rate at 32 cents, and the city is not in the land business, Mayor Isen says.

To date, the school board has been on stage with its views, firing letters of protest to Vice President Nixon, Arthur Fleming, Health, Education and Welfare Secretary, and California's congressmen in Washington.

The Planning Commission is looking forward to the land as a result of the recent ruling by Franklin Floete, General Services Administration head. The audience in this Torrance drama yet to be heard from is the man-in-the-street, the new comer, the citizen with children underfoot or of the way.

The City Council has confirmed Mayor Norris Poulson's re-appointment of Frode B. Kilstofte, Wilmington businessman and civic leader, to a five-year term on the Commission. He was appointed to the Recreation and Park Commission by Mayor Poulson on Sept. 20, 1956, and was its president for the fiscal year 1957-58. He is immediate past-president of the Coliseum Commission and is now a member of that Commission.
