

Project to Begin to Improve Road

Contract for the improvement of the 206th and Harvard Blvd. improvement district has been awarded, according to Councilman John S. Gibson, and work is expected to begin immediately.

Griffith Co., of Wilmington, submitted the lowest of seven bids. The offer of \$188,199 was approximately 18 per cent less than engineers estimates.

Included in the project are improvements on all streets from 203rd to and including the north side of Torrance Blvd., between Denker Ave. and Western Ave. Paving curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and where necessary, sanitary sewer lines, and storm drain improvements are included.

This job, Councilman Gibson said, "is the largest single assessment act proceedings in the history of the 15th District." Most of the cost will be borne by adjacent property owners on the basis of benefits received. Public funds totaling almost \$60,000 have been made available for improvements in excess of the normal requirements for a residential area.

Work already has begun on the lowering of water and gas lines, and construction of other portions of the job will be expedited, in order to complete the improvement ahead of the winter rains.

This project first was petitioned for in 1956, but not until mid 1957, could a majority petition be obtained.

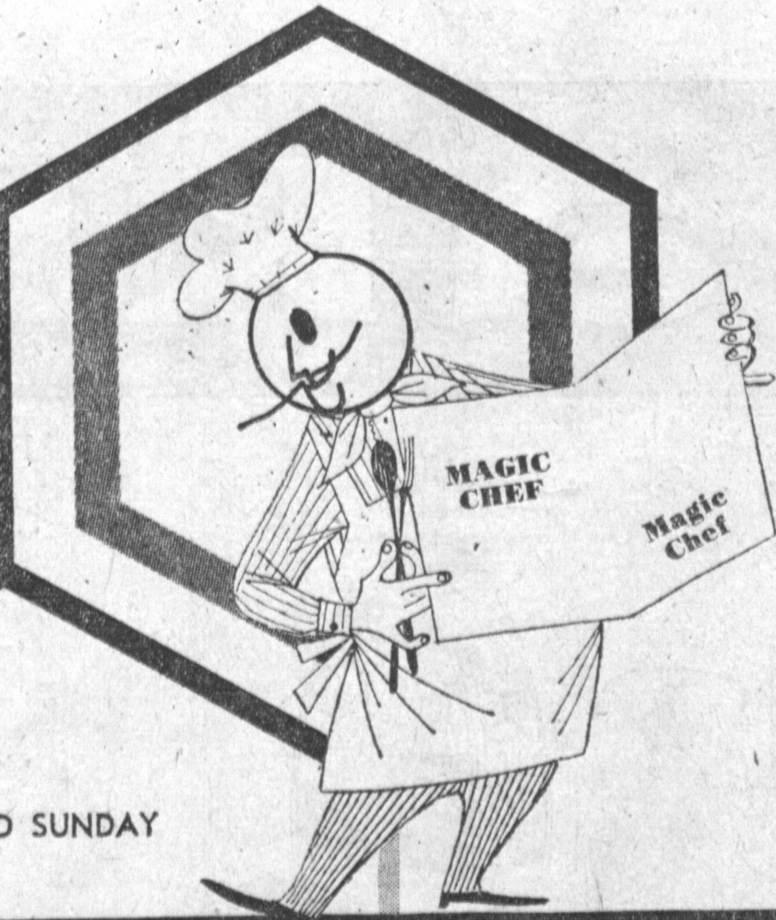
