Elementary Spanish II and intermediate Spanish I will meet Mondays from 6:30 to 9:30 and Wednesdays from 8 to 10 p.m. The instructor will be Helen Crone, linguist, in-

terpreter, and translator. Educated in Cuba, she has traveled widely, speaks five languages fluently, and has been a graduate student and instructor at the University

of Southern California. All classes will include fundamentals of Spanish pronunciation and grammar, the building of a practical vocabulary, and the development of the ability to read, write, and speak Spanish. All courses carry fully transferable credit to other colleges

and universities. Record, films, and other audic - visual aids will be used to promote conversational ability and class inter-

"For most Californias, Spanish is the most practical foreign language to study because of our traditions and customs and the proximity of Mexico. Increasing trade and cultural relations with Latin America lend added importance to Spanish, a tongue spoken by over 80,000,000 peo-

ple," Williams pointed out. New students who wish to register in Spanish or any of 200 other extended day classes could file an application for admission and a request for a registration permit at the college admissions office. and arrange for their previous high school and college transcripts to be mailed to

Harbor College. Currently enrolled and returning evening college students who have not already registered could file a request for a registration permit, which will be mailed to qualified applicants and indicate the date on which they should register.
