ECC Kiwanis Sponsor Trip to Disneyland

Bugs Bunny, Davey Crockett, Donald Duck, Tom Sawyer and many many other storybook, funnypaper, comic book, and movie heroes were visited recently by 30 orphans as 17 El Camino Kiwanis Club members escorted the children to Disneyland for a day of fantasy under county supervision.

This is the third year the club has sponsored the event. It is considered the most important project for the year sponsored by the El Camino group.

Through this event, the Kiwanis disolved that it hopes to provide homes for these children of minority race backgrounds and mixed parentage.

Torrance residents among the escorts were Nelson Allen, principal of the Lawndale School District; John Rudberg, restaurant manager; and Dr. Aldin Young, doctor of dental surgery.

The children were picked up by the Kiwanis group at the L.A. County Bureau of Adoption in Los Angeles and driven to Disneyland where they spent the day.

"It is hoped this will in some way effect more public awareness of the needs of the minority group children who are without homes," spokesman for the group said.

Recruitment of Negro and Mexican American adoptive homes is one of the major concerns of the Bureau. In 1959, the results were very gratifying in that 714 adoptions were completed through the efforts of this program. Interested parties may contact the L.A. County Bureau of Adoptions at 1550 W.
