

## Marine Unit Participates in Air-Ground Exercise

The Fifth Communication in a three-day air-ground ex-Company, local Marine Corps Reserve unit, will take part

The exercise will take place Aug. 22-25, at the Marin Corps Base, 29 Palms, California, the world's largest Marine Corps installation.

Concept of the exercise.

Concept of the exercise, code-named "Operation Charger," is the seizure of aggressor-held areas with the use of close air support to increase the proficiency of air and ground unit co-ordination. Tank and helicopted training will also be included in this Mojave desert exercise.

When the Operation hegins, MAGTF-21 will launch a co-ordinated air-ground attack against aggressor forces that will be defending a simulated airfield. After the capture of the Field, the Task Force will be prepared to continue the attack against "enemy" forces to the north.

General training objectives of the three-day problem will be reconnaissance and patrol missions, (emphasizing night patrolling), maximum air support participation and at least three helicopter assault

other training objectives include fire support co-ord, nation, offensive operations (including night movements and attacks), defense of stratigic areas, atomic aspects of land warfare (both offensive and defensive), tank-infantry attacks, air defense and command post emplacement, security and displacement, and

communications functioning.

Before Operation Charge goes into effect, however, the Reserve organizations will undergo seven days of rigorous Hi-Desert training.




